MNCE (Mean Normal Curve Equivalent):

The **MEAN** is the quotient obtained by dividing the sum of a set of scores by the number of scores; also called “**average.**” **Normal Curve Equivalent (NCEs)** are like percentiles. **Both an NCE of 50 and a percentile of 50 are exactly average. An NCE of 50 is at grade level.** Regardless of the time of year at which testing is done and grade level tested, a properly derived NCE score of 50 will always be the national average for that grade level and month.
